(Example, 5 or 10 year parts and 5 year limited labor.) <input type="checkbox"/> Maximum warranty upgrade. (Example, 10 year parts and 10 years limited labor.) <hr/>
11. <u>Duct Cleaning</u>	<input type="checkbox"/> No Duct cleaning <input type="checkbox"/> Add duct cleaning at the time the new heating and cooling system is installed <input type="checkbox"/> Add duct cleaning at a later date. <hr/>
12. <u>Geothermal Option: Desuperheater</u>	<input type="checkbox"/> No DHW Desuperheater <input type="checkbox"/> Add DHW Desuperheater to geothermal system. Connect to customer water heater. <input type="checkbox"/> Add DHW Desuperheater to geothermal system and preheat tank for water heater. (If adding DHW, Precision Comfort Systems recommends the preheat tank.) <hr/>
13. <u>Geothermal Option: Intellistart</u>	<input type="checkbox"/> No Intellistart <input type="checkbox"/> Add Intellistart to geothermal system for soft start. <hr/>
